

## FAQs about travel to Project SMART-2017 – To parents and students

### 2. Does the program provide sheets, covers and towels for our students?

The Housing office will be able to provide international students and others who may desire with all bedding and towel needs at an additional cost of \$20 per week.

### 3. What are the arrangements for the residence halls in terms of roommates, etc.?

Project SMART students will be living in one residence hall (Engelhardt Hall) for the duration of the program. Students will be separated by gender on different floors. All students will have a roommate throughout the program.

### 4. Is it possible to send last year's (or even this year's) program?

We will have a tentative program posted on the web by June 25 – events may change due to weather or availability of guest speakers, etc.

### 5. How is the transportation from the airport to the program handled?

If several (3-4) students are arriving at the same time, we'll pick them up from the Boston (BOS Logan) airport; otherwise, they may travel by C&J bus (<https://www.ridecj.com/schedules/> - please copy and paste if it does not work) to Portsmouth NH – about 70 min ride; and we'll bring them to UNH from the Bus stop in Portsmouth. Please check the C&J Bus website for the most up-to-date fees for tickets. Let us know if you are below 16 years; the bus will not let you travel alone. We'll confirm the pick up schedule a week before your arrival.

### 6. What are the arrival dates and times?

The students should arrive on Sunday the 2<sup>nd</sup> of July and leave either after 7:00 pm on the 28<sup>th</sup> of July or any time on the 29<sup>th</sup> of July. If you are being dropped off by car, please arrive at Engelhardt Hall between 3:00 and 5:00 PM on the afternoon on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. The parents can stay for Sunday evening meeting and also join us on Monday morning until lunchtime. They can join the kids for lunch at \$12 ea. For those who are flying in, and a flight for Sunday arrival or Friday departure is not feasible, you can arrive a day earlier and leave a day later. IF YOU ARE NOT ARRIVING ON JULY 2 OR NOT LEAVING ON JULY 28, PLEASE LET US KNOW.

8. Rooms do not have an AC. A fan can be arranged for those who are flying in; others please bring a pedestal or a table fan with you.
